"Combines 54/34/9% merlot/cabernet sauvignon/cabernet franc and the all-important 1% glug of petit verdot. Reflecting its regional bearings brilliantly and a bargain to boot. Florals, red fruits, just a hint of raspberry confectionary and no shortage of spices either. Medium bodied at best, a coating of furry ripe tannins and sweet fruit crossing to a savouriness."

"Dark red in color, the nose is intense with aromas of blackberry, blueberry and anise combined with delicate smoky-coffee French oak. The palate is medium bodied with a soft round Merlot mouthfeel and black fruit flavors, with a touch of liquorice and blueberry. This wine will reward careful cellaring, and we recommend decanting before drinking."

THE WINEMAKER

Doug Balnaves and his wife Annette established Balnaves of Coonawarra with their first 5 hectares of vineyards planted in 1975. Doug's children, Kirsty and Pete, returned home to join the family company in 1990. The Balnaves winery was constructed in 1995, and current winemaker, Jacinta Jenkins, joined the team in 2020.
